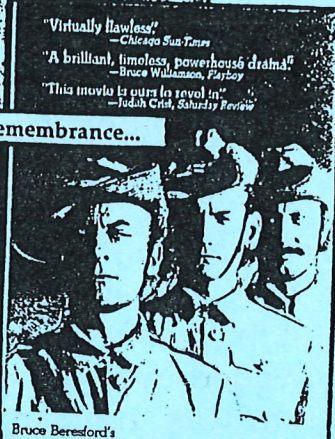

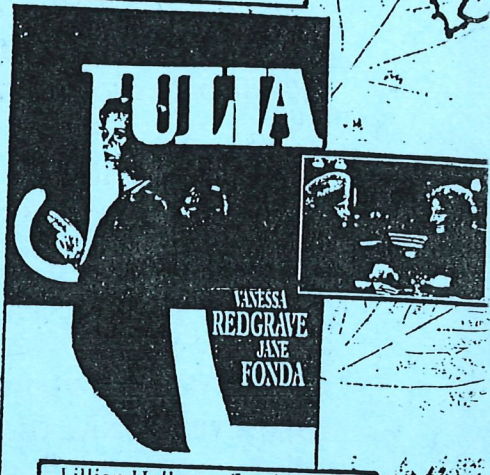
Beresford's Classic Aussie film. During the Boer War - the crush of state over individual integrity in wartime. PG13 some violence

Lillian Hellman, Fonda, recalls being swept into her lifelong friend's 1930's political intrigue Rich, brilliant screenplay PG

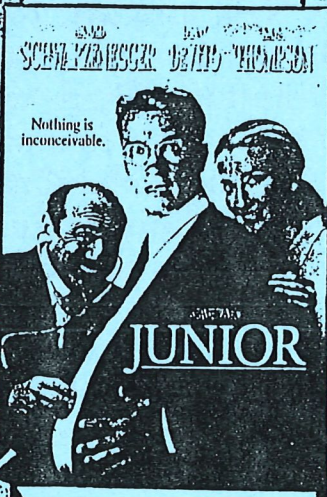

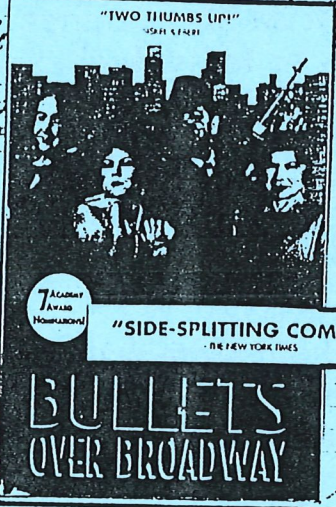

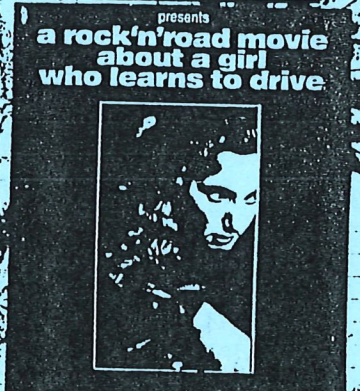
