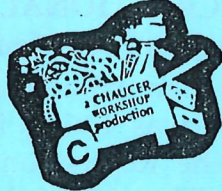
Outrageous

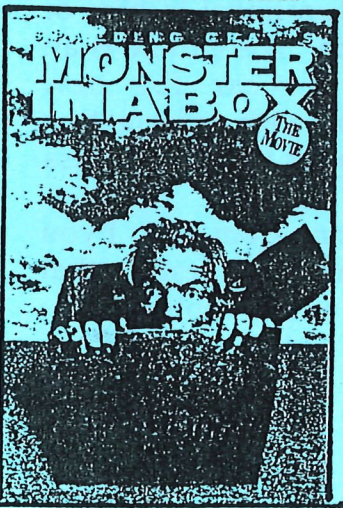

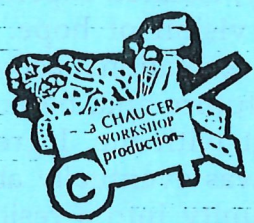

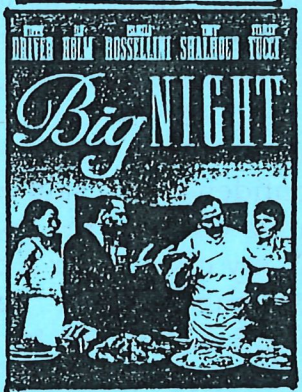
For Remembrance Day
