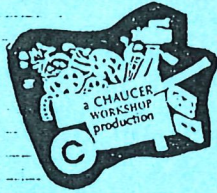

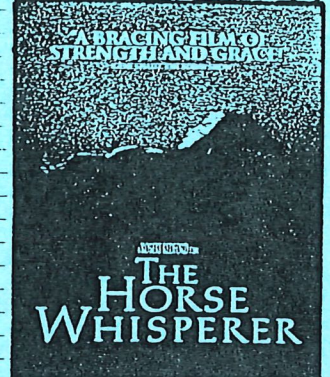

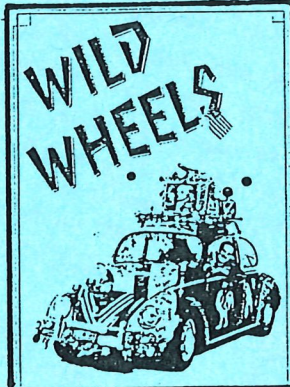

## CRY FREEDOM

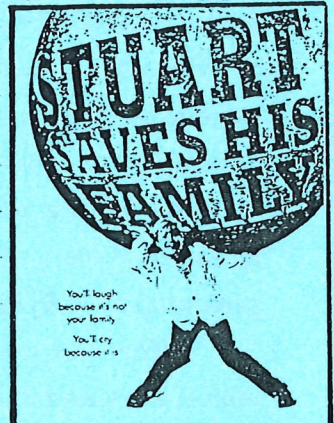
