HORSES IN WINTER



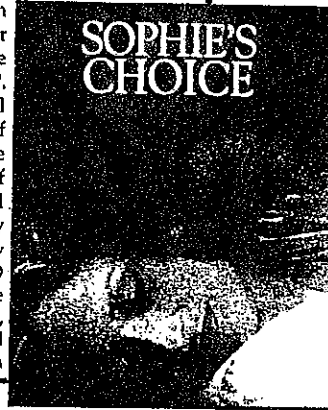

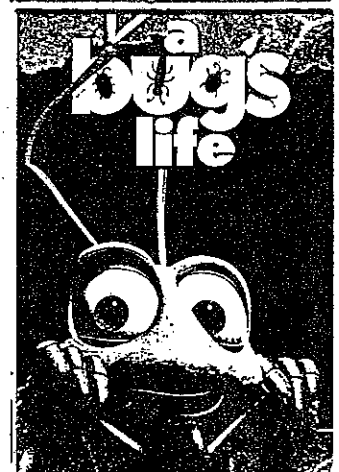
