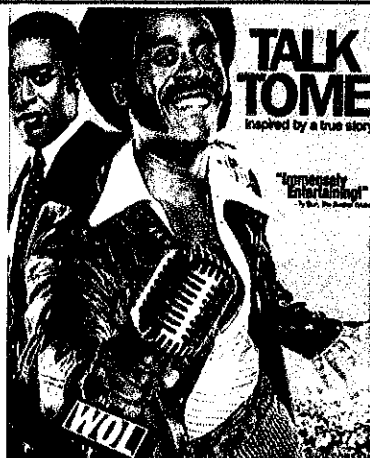


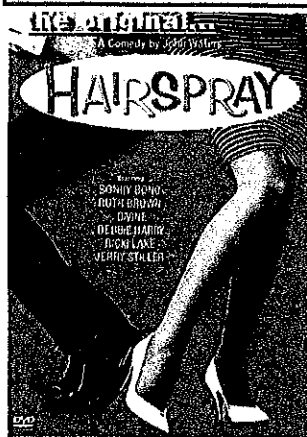

We'll talk about the real story, which, as usual, is more amazing than the Hollywood package. 118min R for funky bad language throughout

This doc will be a reminder, around the anniversary 27 years ago, of John Lennon's untimely death, of his valor and no-retreat mindset. John's amazing career is described but also the cat and mouse game, pitting his fame and eccentric peace activities against a paranoid regime - and the paranoia it in turn created in his life. With songs such as "Imagine," "Give Peace A Chance", "Happy Xmas (War Is Over)" and "Revolution" and the infamous Bed-In, Lennon challenged the government-of-the-time's oppressive behavior in a situation similar to today's. 96min Pg13

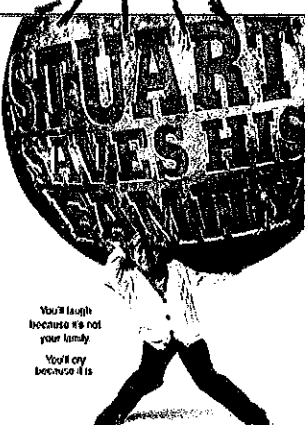
