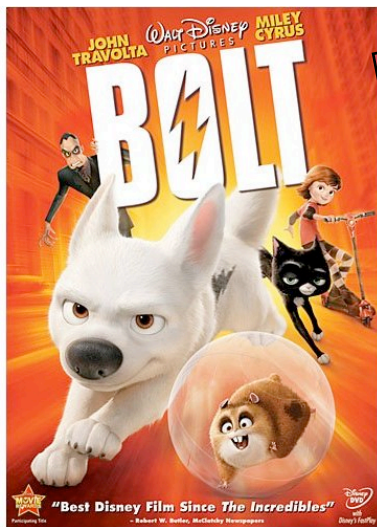

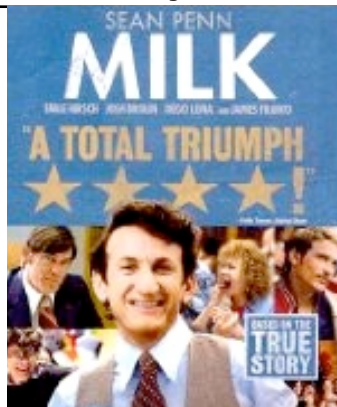

This remarkable film is about passionate three-decade relationship between two men, 3 decades apart in age and openly gay in an era when homosexual relationships were mostly "in the closet". British writer Christopher Isherwood (whose Berlin Stories became the hit *Cabaret*) and Don Bachardy who became known for celebrity portraits and nude studies, grew up and old as a couple. Not just a great story but a beautifully realized film; amazing archival footage, candid interviews especially from Don, and a heartening theme of acceptance and the triumph of art in a life. 90min 2007 PG13
