How do people learn to live rather than to die? NFB's *Drawing from Life* follows a group therapy workshop for people who have attempted suicide more than once. A hybrid of vérité documentary and animation, this unusual film's visual metaphors illuminate the thoughts and feelings of its participants.

This is a candid portrayal of twelve people who together, for 20 weeks, take on their fears, their behaviors and their ghosts to move towards life and away from suicide.

It's a surprisingly uplifting and universal story about what it means to be alive.
