place and culture - and **THE SHADOW CATCHER 1974 88min PG** A documentary about the life and work of American Indian ethnographer Edward Curtis, narrated by Patrick Watson, Curtis' letters voiced by Donald Sutherland. Here are a couple of films that go together. **Cry Rock** is a new film by Writer/Director/Producer Banchi Hanuse (Sits'Lani) about understanding the value of the oral traditions of Bella Coola Valley elders, about whether to use technology to record these stories, better they be learned and internalized. It's interesting to juxtapose it with a 36 year old film **The Shadow Catcher**, about Curtis' monumental life work to record in photos, film, and text as much of "The Vanishing Race" as possible.
