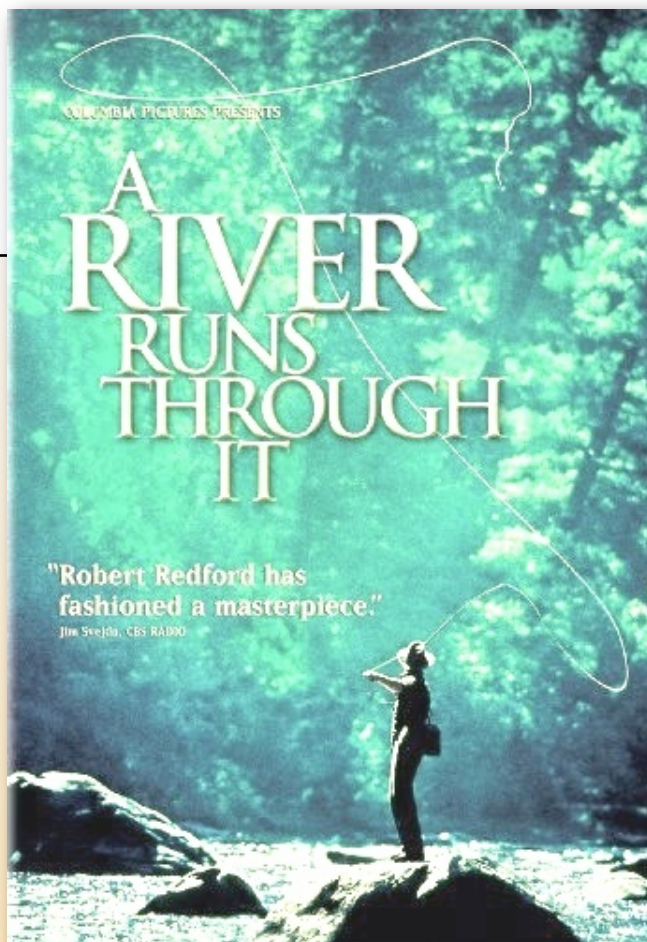


MOVIE MONDAY'S THURSDAY MOVIE on 3B

Set in and around the city of Missoula in western Montana, the story follows two sons of a Presbyterian minister—one studious and the other rebellious—as they grow up and come of age in a time that roughly spans the Prohibition era in the United States to the early days of the Great Depression. Fly fishing is their common bond and the river the steady through-line in the story. This film is renowned for its beautiful cinematography and its un-Hollywood style leisurely pacing.



Robert Redford directed this film classic and made the crucial decision to keep [the book's author] Maclean's voice in the film; his own prose is read as a narration, by Redford, so that we do not simply see events as they happen, we are reminded that they are memories from long ago, and that the author has spent time and trouble to draw the lessons from them.
