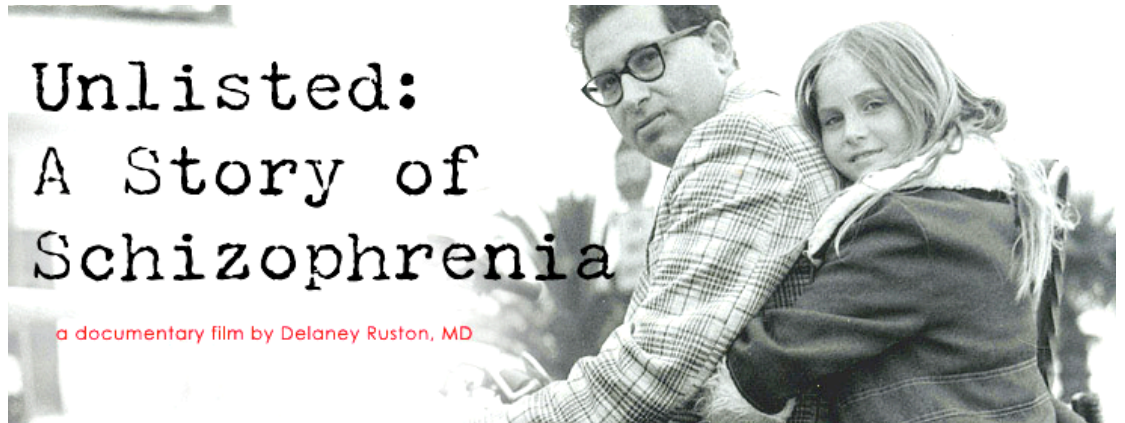

Films by MyDoc productions have focused on controversial medical themes. Ruston has also just completed *Crisis and Control: What's the Role of Psychiatric Advance Directives*

Ruston completed medical school at Stanford University and a Medicine Residency and Fellowship in Medical Ethics at the University of California at San Francisco. All the while Delaney has been producing films, she has also been providing primary medical care in clinics for under-served patients, particularly the Pikes Market district of Seattle. She lives with her husband and two young children.
