Here's a documentary about an amazing 86 year old Victoria artist, Bob Choma, who is bipolar. A graduate of our Eric Martin Pavilion, his life has been a classic creative, chaotic story - from being taught by several of the Group of Seven as a kid, running a couple of highly productive businesses, he has been a cartoonist, futurist - general sparky guy. Bob has been challenged by mood swings and alcohol problems through that colourful life, but in recent years he is well and has rediscovered his creative muse as an outsider artist.

A film 17 years in the making. Beyond a story about one man's journey, this project hopes to provide insights into the connection between the bipolar condition, and creativity, and how vital that connection is for some of us.
