In **Before Sunrise 105min 1995 R (language)**, a young American lad meets a French girl on a train to Vienna where they get to know each other overnight before he leaves on his flight home. In the second, **Before Sunset 80min 2004 R (language)**, they meet again after 9 years. Life has moved on but the spark is still there. You'll want to see these two films together. In a month, we'll show the third, **Before Midnight (2013)**. It continues this fascinating relationship of both these fictional characters and their creators in this, hopefully, ongoing series.
