Colin and Julie Angus, now living in Victoria, have made a habit of adventuring then writing books and putting documentaries together about their journeys. **THE YENISEY EXPEDITION** took Colin and friends from the heart of Mongolia north through Siberia, and on to the Arctic Ocean by kayak, rubber raft and improvised rowboat. 59min 2002 Pg In **BEYOND THE HORIZON** a team of three, including Colin and his fiancée (now wife), Julie, completed the first human-powered circumnavigation of the globe – the team cycled, skied, canoed,

hiked and rowed a route that took them to Alaska, across the Bering Sea, through a Siberian winter, across Europe from Moscow to Portugal, then across the Atlantic to Costa Rica—a 156-day rowing odyssey.
