IN THE TURN



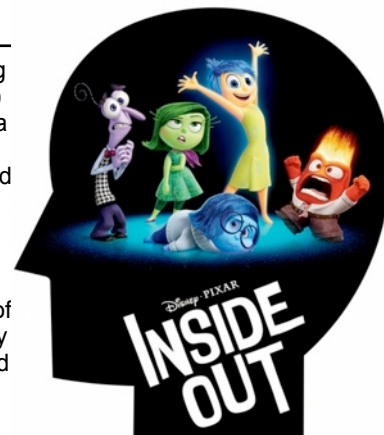
IN THE TURN follows Crystal, a 10-year-old transgender girl growing up in rural Canada, as she navigates the difficult and complicated world that surrounds her. After being denied the right to join local athletics teams due to her gender, Crystal and her mom serendipitously discover the Vagine Regime, an international queer collective of roller derby players comprised of people of all shapes, sizes, backgrounds and identities. The Vagine Regime not only accepts Crystal, but actively supports her journey. Crystal emerges from exclusion into empowerment: she steps out of the shadows and onto the track. For the Moment is a 1993 film written and directed by Aaron Kim Johnston and starring Russell Crowe (in his breakout role) and Christianne Hirt. The plot revolves

around airmen training in rural Manitoba, Canada, with the British Commonwealth Air Training Plan during the Second World War. Central to the story is the wartime romance between Russell Crowe's character and a local girl.
