Forty-year-old Adam's lonely, quiet life is interrupted when he gets a phone call from his hysterical ex-girlfriend, Miriam, who is trying to get pregnant with a donor's sperm. The day she inseminates herself, they wind up in bed together. Now for the twist: Adam is transgendered. Four years ago, he started his transition from female to male but it isn't quite complete. In fact, he gets a little bit pregnant himself. 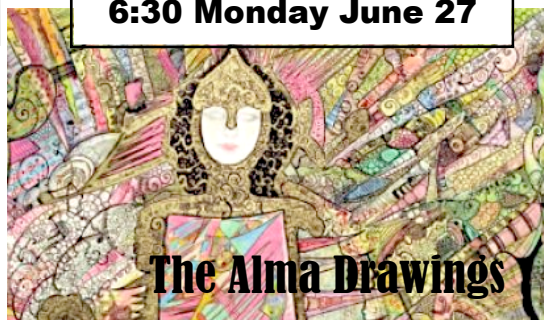

Alma Rumball was a sweet, simple woman who spent most of her years living in a small cabin in rural Ontario, Canada. But as she neared the age of 50, something remarkable happened: Alma had a vision in which Christ told her to bring a message to the world. Soon after, she began to produce hundreds of mystical, mythical drawings, full of astonishingly vivid detail. She claimed no authorship of these works, explaining that "The Hand" produced them automatically, without conscious guidance. Was she in the grip of some madness? Or did Alma possess unique access to a world beyond our own?
