PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

On Monday, July 13th at 6:30pm, Movie Monday will be holding an event on service dogs.

Celeste Macevicius, who is currently on the waitlist for a psychiatric service dog, will share her own service dog story as well as host. Through videos, photographs, speaking, guest presenters, and Q&A's, the event will explore what service dogs are, what they can do, and how they help people with a wide range of disabilities and conditions.

Special guests include Linda Bartram, who is currently paired with her fourth guide dog, and Lisa, who has a service dog from Pacific Assistance Dogs Society (PADS BC).

As well as the presentation, there will be information and fundraisers in the lobby. Fundraisers will include a concession, raffle basket, and art cards for sale.

The proceeds of admission (by donation) and the fundraising will help Celeste raise money for her own service dog from Brigadoon Service Dogs in Bellingham.

Brigadoon is a non-profit that, due to the substantial costs associated with raising a service dog, asks that applicants raise \$10,000, just a part of the estimated \$30,000 it takes to raise a dog.
