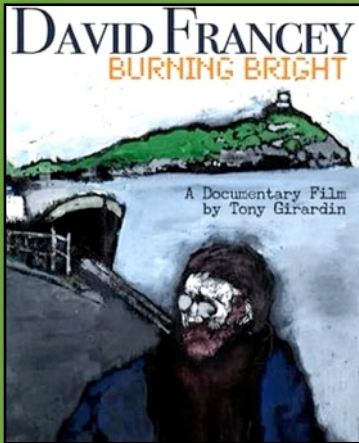


at **MOVIE MONDAY**
